Domestic Broad-leaved Species Collection Garden



Japan has distributed many broad-leaved species because of long country from north to south and has difference climate conditions.

There are dominated by deciduous broad-leaved species such as beech, zelkova and oak from north of the Chubu region which is region in the middle of Honshu island, and by evergreen broad-leaved species from south of the Chubu region.

There are Yaeyama shitan (*Pterocarpus vidalianus* Rolfe) and Banyan tree (*Ficus microcarpa* L.) in Okinawa Prefecture of subtropical areas.

It is a major characteristic of Japanese forest distributing of such wide variety of tree species from subarctic zone to subtropical zone.
